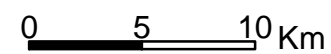
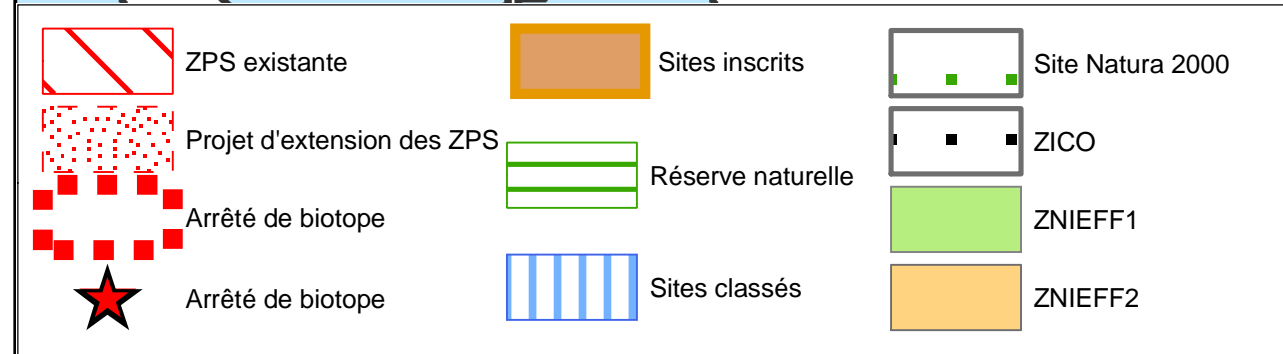

Protections réglementaires et inventaires écologiques
